

Third Floor Overview

Before exiting the main staircase on the third and final floor, the intricately designed tin ceiling catches every eye. Bathrooms can be found to either side and the elevator is to the left back, as it is on the other floors. The cafeteria, located behind the staircase, is accessible to all students and staff, regardless of disability. Every student will spend a recently extended thirty-minute lunch break here during their third block class. Allowing students to have a fuller, more enjoyable lunch will be achieved this year with two serving lines and a much larger area for students to dine. This will cut the lunch blocks to three instead of the previous four. There are two outside entrances on the far walls. The left entrance opens to the beautiful amphitheater while the right exits to a loading dock and staff parking.

Straight ahead, out of the cafeteria, the business labs including room 317, taught by Angela Thompson, and room 318, instructed by Gail Widener, cannot be missed. The labs handle more students and will consist of com-

puter-based classes in the business field. All the way down the left hall, past stairwell two, the bathrooms, and another left turn arrives to the Literature Department. The classrooms and teachers are as follows:

room 325 – Amanda Pike, room 324 – Brad McLain, and room 323 – Rebekah Lowery. This hall's stairwell is located to the side of Lowry's classroom.

Continuing right of the business labs, however, leads to the Social Studies wing, which includes room 367 taught by Wylene Spearman. Bathrooms and stairwell four are also along this hall, along with assistant principal Chris Edwards' Office. After the corner, rooms 370 – Bobby Cothran, 371 – Paul Mixon, and 373 – Lance Taylor can be found in that order. The fifth stairwell is across from Mixon's classroom. Two wonderful window displays rest at the foot of both side corridors, one on each hall of this floor. They overlook the front parking lot and a section of the road. Aside from a colorful view, the fixtures themselves are a great addition as they provide light for both halls.
